06 vacancies (3 UR; 2 OBC; & 1 ST) for the post of Parliamentary Reporter Gd. - II in Lok Sabha Secretariat were notified *vide* Advt. No. 7/2012. The revised vacancy position for the post as on 24.04.2014 was 07 (4 UR; 2 OBC; & 1 ST) (06 English; & 01 Hindi).

2. On the basis of the performance in Preliminary Examination, Stenography Tests and Personal Interview held on 09.06.2013, 21 & 22.12.2013 and 09.04.2014, respectively, the candidates having the following Roll Nos. have been declared successful:-

3. The candidate having Roll No. 800 who belonged to SC category, availed the benefit of his category in the marks for qualifying the Preliminary Examination. He was, therefore, not eligible for being considered for appointment against a UR vacancy. There was no vacancy in SC category.

4. The cut-off percentage of marks in the Personal Interview were 50% for UR vacancies, 45% for OBC vacancies and 40% for SC/ST vacancies.
