Subject: Final Result of examination for recruitment to the post of Junior Clerk in Lok Sabha Secretariat in response to Advt. No. 7/2017.

On the basis of the performance in Preliminary Examination held on 08.10.2017 and Main Examination consisting of Typing Test held on 24.02.2018 and Descriptive Type Written Paper held on 25.02.2018, the candidates having the following Roll Nos. have been declared successful in English stream:

The result against 01 vacancy reserved for physically challenged persons having visual impairment (low vision) has been kept withheld.

2. All candidates were required to qualify the Paper-I: Typing Test at the requisite speed of 40 w.p.m. The cut-off percentage of marks in the Paper-II: Essay, Letter and Grammar was 50% for UR vacancies, 45% for OBC vacancies and 40% for SC/ST vacancies. The above percentages were relaxable by 5% in case of physically challenged persons of relevant disability and category.

3. In the Advertisement No. 7/2017 and also in the Call Letter issued to the candidates, it was mentioned that the answer sheets of the Descriptive Type Written Paper of only those candidates who qualify Typing Test would be got evaluated. Accordingly, the answer sheets of Paper-II of only 65 candidates have been got evaluated. 03 more candidates having Roll Nos. 160188, 161383 and 185650 also qualified the Typing Test but they did not appear in the Descriptive Type Written Paper. No candidate could qualify the typing test in Hindi stream. The marks secured by the candidates in Papers-I and II are being put on our website <http://www.loksabha.nic.in>

4. The attention of candidates mentioned in para 1 above is, however, drawn to the following declaration made by them in their applications to the above said post:

"I declare that I have minutely read the relevant advertisement and I fulfil the eligibility conditions as per the advertisement and that all the statements made in this application are true, complete and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that in the event of any information being found false or incorrect at any stage or not satisfying the eligibility conditions according to the requirements mentioned in the advertisement, my candidature/appointment is liable to be cancelled/terminated. I have also noted that if my application is found incomplete/defective, the same is liable to be rejected summarily and no correspondence will be entertained by Lok Sabha Secretariat in this regard."

5. The name of the post has been revised as 'Secretariat Assistant'. However, the revision of nomenclature doesn't involve change in duties and responsibilities and any additional financial benefits.
