**Subject: Result of the Competitive Departmental Examination for the post of Junior Library Attendant in Lok Sabha Secretariat held on 27.10.2012 in response to Circular No. 27767 dated 18.09.2012**

On the basis of the performance in the above said examination, the candidates having the following Roll Nos. have been declared successful for appointment to the post of Junior Library Attendant:

2. The minimum qualifying marks in the above examination were 50% and 45% in each component and aggregate for UR and OBC vacancies, respectively.

As per the present practice followed by Joint Recruitment Cell, Other Backward Classes (OBC) means those communities as included and specified in the Central Government list of the Backward Classes. OBC certificate of a candidate must show that the caste the candidate belongs to is recognised as OBC under various Resolutions of the Ministry of Welfare, Government of India, and that the person does not belong to creamy layer section. Candidates claiming to be belonging to OBC but not submitting OBC certificate which satisfies these two conditions are treated as General Category candidates and are not provided any benefit available to OBC candidates.
