**Subject: Final Result of examination for recruitment to the post of
Junior Clerk in Lok Sabha Secretariat - Advt. No. 1/2013.**

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23 (20 UR; 01 OBC; & 02 SC) vacancies for the post of Junior Clerk were notified *vide* Advertisement No. 1/2013. 01 vacancy, out of these, was reserved for Physically Handicapped Persons (Visual Impairment). As on 31.12.2013, the vacancy position for the post was: SC-03; OBC-06; and UR-28 - Total: 37 (33 Eng.; & 04 Hindi), 01 vacancy reserved for Physically Handicapped Persons with visual impairment. There was no ST vacancy.

2. On the basis of the performance in Preliminary Examination held on 29.09.2013 and Main Examination held on 25 & 26.05.2014, the candidates having the following Roll Nos. have been declared successful;

3. The cut-off percentage of marks in the Descriptive Type Written Paper was 50% for UR vacancies, 45% for OBC vacancies and 40% for SC/ST vacancies. The above percentages were relaxable by 5% in case of Physically Handicapped Persons of relevant disability and category. All candidates were required to qualify the typing test at the requisite speed of 40 w.p.m.

4. In the Advertisement No. 1/2013, it was mentioned that the answer sheets of the Descriptive Type Written Paper of only those candidates who qualify Typing Test would be got evaluated. Accordingly, the answer sheets of only 75 candidates have been got evaluated. The marks secured by these candidates in Written Paper and Typing Test are being put on our website <http://www.loksabha.nic.in>

No other candidate could qualify the Typing Test. They could not type the minimum required number of strokes/achieve the minimum net speed of 40 w.p.m./committed more than 5% errors in the Typewriting Test. (In Advertisement No. 1/2013, it was clearly mentioned that not more than 5% errors are allowed for passing the Typewriting Test.) They have secured zero marks in the Typing Test.

5. The attention of candidates is, however, drawn to the following declaration made by them in their applications to the above said post:

"I declare that I fulfil the eligibility conditions as per the advertisement and that all the statements made in this application are true, complete and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that in the event of any information being found false or incorrect at any stage or not satisfying the eligibility conditions according to the requirements mentioned in the advertisement, my candidature/appointment is liable to be cancelled/terminated."
