**RESULT OF THE EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF PARLIAMENTARY  
INTERPRETER GRADE-II IN LOK SABHA SECRETARIAT – ADVT. NO. 4/2012**

One vacancy each in Marathi and Tamil streams for the post of Parliamentary Interpreter Gd.-II in Lok Sabha Secretariat were notified *vide* Advertisement No. 4/2012. The examination of the eligible candidates was held as per the following schedule:

Oration Test: 19.10.2012  
Written Test: 20.10.2012  
Interpretation Test: 23.10.2012

Each of the above tests was elimination round for the subsequent test. No candidate in the above streams could qualify the Interpretation Test. Hence, the last stage of examination i.e. Personal Interview in respect of the vacancies in the above streams was not held.

2. In Oration and Simultaneous Interpretation Tests, the candidates were required to secure minimum 50% marks in each component/parameter. The minimum cut-off percentage of marks in Written Test and Personal Interview were 50%, 45% and 40% for vacancies in GEN, OBC and SC/ST categories, respectively.
