The above candidate will have to qualify the typing test at the speed of 40 w.p.m. on computer within one year of his appointment to the post of Junior Clerk failing which he shall not be allowed to draw subsequent increments in the grade.

3. The candidates bearing roll numbers 2, 16, 18, 24, 28, 37, 47, 67, 72, 84, 87, 90, 95, 96, 98, 102 and 104 could not qualify the typing test. Accordingly, their answer sheets for Paper-II : Essay, Letter and Grammer have not been got evaluated. The candidates bearing roll number 13 and 97 who cleared both typing test and the descriptive type written test did not find a place in the merit lists, as there was only one vacancy in the UR category.
