**05.11.2011 (Saturday) - Roll Nos. 100077 to 104466**  
**06.11.2011 (Sunday) - Roll Nos. 104535 to 200229**
3. The cut-off percentage of marks in the Main Examination (in each paper and aggregate) is 50% for UR vacancies, 45% for OBC vacancies and 40% for SC/ST vacancies.

5. The candidates should bring the following documents/testimonials at the time of Personal Interview:
  - (i) Original certificate of Matriculation or equivalent examination as proof of date of birth.
  - (ii) All original certificates of Educational and other qualifications.
  - (iii) Original Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority (in case of SC, ST and OBC candidates).
6. The minimum cut-off percentages of marks in Personal Interview is 50%, 45% and 40% for vacancies in GENERAL, OBC and SC/ST categories, respectively.
7. From amongst the candidates who qualify the Personal Interview, selection will be made on the basis of overall performance of the candidates in the Main Examination and the Personal Interview, subject to the availability of vacancies.
8. The attention of candidates is drawn to the following declaration made by them in their applications to the above said post:
