- (ii) Graduation or examination for higher educational qualification last passed *(before the last date for submission of applications for the post of Junior Parliamentary Reporter in Rajya Sabha Secretariat in response to Advertisement No. 4/2009)*
- (iii) Caste Certificate (in case of SC, ST and OBC candidates)
