2. The cut-off percentage of marks in the Descriptive Type Written Paper was 50% for UR vacancies, 45% for OBC vacancies and 40% for SC/ST vacancies. The above percentages were relaxable by 5% in case of physically handicapped persons of relevant disability and category. All candidates were required to qualify the Stenography Test at the requisite speed of 80 w.p.m.

3. In the Advertisement No. 4/2009, it was mentioned that the answer sheets of the Descriptive Type Written Paper of only those candidates who qualify Typing Test would be got evaluated. Accordingly, the answer sheets of only 17 candidates have been got evaluated. The marks secured by these candidates in Written Paper and Stenography Test are being put on our website <http://www.parliamentofindia.nic.in>

In the Call Letter issued to the candidates, it was mentioned that not more than 5% errors are allowed for passing the Stenography Test. The remaining candidates who appeared in the Stenography Test have committed more than 5% errors. They have been declared 'failed' in the Stenography Test.

4. The attention of candidates is, however, drawn to the following declaration made by them in their applications to the above said post:

"I declare that I fulfil the eligibility conditions as per the advertisement and that all the statements made in this application are true, complete and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand that in the event of any information being found false or incorrect at any stage or not satisfying the eligibility conditions according to the requirements mentioned in the advertisement, my candidature/appointment is liable to be cancelled/terminated."
