In the Advertisement No. 4/2011, it was mentioned that a candidate will have to qualify the Paper-I: Essay, Letter and Grammar and Paper-II: Typing Test in the same stream. Two candidates having Roll Nos. 700789 (attempted the Paper-I in English stream) and 700818 (attempted the Paper-I in Hindi stream), and also appeared in the typing tests in both English and Hindi streams. The candidate having Roll No. 700789 qualified the typing test in Hindi stream securing 40 marks but he could not qualify the typing test in the required English stream. The candidate having roll No. 700818 qualified the typing test in English stream securing 50 marks but he could not qualify the typing test in the required Hindi stream. Their answer sheets for Paper-I have not, therefore, been got evaluated.

No other candidate could qualify the Hindi Typing Test.

The remaining candidates could not type the minimum required number of strokes/committed more than 5% errors in the Typewriting Test. In Advertisement No. 4/2011 and also in the Call Letter issued to the candidates, it was clearly mentioned that not more than 5% errors are allowed for passing the Typewriting Test. Their answer sheets for Paper-I have not been got evaluated.
