

**Result of Written Examination for filling up vacancies for the post of Hindi Assistant in Lok Sabha Secretariat by transfer on deputation/absorption basis**

2. The cut-off percentage of marks in the above Written Examination is 50% in each component and aggregate.

3. The candidates appearing for the Personal Interview should bring the following original certificates for verification and also submit a copy each of the same (*after indicating in pen his/her Roll No. for the present examination for the post of Hindi Assistant*) **duly attested by a First Class Magistrate or Gazetted Officer:**

- (i) Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate as proof of date of birth
- (ii) Certificates of educational and other qualifications
- (iii) Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority (*in case of SC, ST and OBC candidates*)

The candidates are also required to submit the following, in case the same have not already been submitted:

- (i) Certificate from the Head of Office of the applicant (as prescribed in the advertisement for the said post)
- (ii) Copies of Annual Confidential Reports for the last 5 years or the actual period of service whichever is less.

4. The minimum cut-off percentage of marks in the Personal Interview is 50%.

5. The candidates may please note that their candidature is provisional and the same can be cancelled at any time in case any declaration made in the application does not match with the requirements advertised for the post. Each candidate is, therefore, required to satisfy himself/herself that he/she fulfils the eligibility conditions for the post as advertised before appearing in the personal interview.
