**SUBJECT: RESULT OF THE EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF
PARLIAMENTARY INTERPRETER GRADE-II IN LOK SABHA
SECRETARIAT IN BODO AND GUJARATI STREAMS – ADVT.
NO. 3/2015**

11 vacancies (7 UR; 2 OBC; 1 SC; & 1 ST) [English/Hindi - 4; Regional Languages-7 (1 Bodo, 1 Dogri, 1 Gujarati, 1 Kashmiri, 1 Konkani, 1 Santhali and 1 Sindhi)] for the post of Parliamentary Interpreter Grade-II in Lok Sabha Secretariat were notified in July, 2015 vide Advt. No. 3/2015.

2. In pursuance thereof, in the first instance, Oration Test, Written Test, Simultaneous Interpretation Test and Personal Interview were held from 27.11.2015 to 29.11.2015 for vacancies in Bodo and Gujarati streams at Dispur (Guwahati, Assam) and Gandhinagar (Gujarat), respectively. Each Test was elimination round for the subsequent test.

3. In Oration and Simultaneous Interpretation Tests, the candidates were required to secure minimum 50% marks in each component/parameter. The minimum cut-off percentage of marks in Written Test (in each paper/component) and Personal Interview was 45% and 40% for vacancies in OBC and SC/ST categories, respectively.

4. On the basis of the performance in the above said tests and personal interview, the candidates having the following Roll Nos. have been declared successful:

Roll No. 01 for Gujarati stream. The candidate belongs to 'OBC' category but he has not availed any relaxation available to the candidates belonging to 'OBC' category in the prescribed eligibility conditions for the said post or for qualifying this examination. Hence, he has been declared qualified against 'UR' vacancy.

Roll No. 05 for Bodo stream. The candidate belongs to 'ST' category. He has been declared qualified against 'ST' vacancy.

6. The attention of candidates mentioned in para 4 above is, however, drawn to the following declaration made by them in their applications to the above said post:
