4. No other candidate could qualify the Stenography Test. They could not transcribe the complete Test Passage/committed more than 5% errors in the Transcription of the Test Passage. (In Advertisement No. 1/2017, it was clearly mentioned that not more than 5% errors are allowed for passing the Stenography Test.)
