Brief Profile of Shri Ashish Chakraborty:

Having graduated from Delhi University, Shri Ashish Chakraborty joined Election Commission of India (ECI) in the year 1976 and retired from service in 2014 from the post of Secretary, ECI.

During the period of nearly more than 38 years of service in ECI, he worked in almost all the functional Divisions of ECI, viz. Delimitation, Electoral Roll (Voters, List), Planning for Elections, Conduct of Elections, Judicial Division, etc. He was closely associated with the work of computerization of voters' list and preparation of photo voter list as one of the domain experts.

After retirement, Shri Chakraborty was associated with ECI / IIIDEM (India International Institute for Democracy and Election Management) as a Consultant on a regular basis till 2019. And during this period he organised online as well as offline Training Programmes for District Collector/Magistrates and other senior officials at State/ District level on conduct of elections. He also assisted in development of electoral training content and training methods for capacity building programme for participants from other democratic countries of the world.

Shri Chakraborty was also engaged by IIIDEM as a Domain Expert for preparation of different Modules for international Training on capacity development for conduct of elections.
