Subject: Party Position in Lok Sabha.

Consequent upon his conviction by the Court of Sessions, Kavaratti, Lakshadweep in Sessions case no. 01/2017, Shri Mohammed Faizal P.P. representing the Lakshadweep Parliamentary Constituency of the Union Territory of Lakshadweep stands disqualified from the membership of Lok Sabha from the date of his conviction i.e.11 January, 2023 in terms of the provisions of Article 102(1)(e) of the Constitution of India read with section 8 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951. Accordingly, the strength of Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) has decreased from 5 to 4 in 17th Lok Sabha.

2. Further, consequent upon the demise of Shri Santokh Singh Chaudhary, an elected member from Jalandhar Parliamentary Constituency of Punjab on 14 January, 2023, the strength of Indian National Congress (INC) has decreased from 53 to 52 in 17th Lok Sabha.

3. Therefore, there are now two vacancies in the 17th Lok Sabha.

4. The revised Party Position in 17th Lok Sabha as on 14.1.2023 is enclosed.
